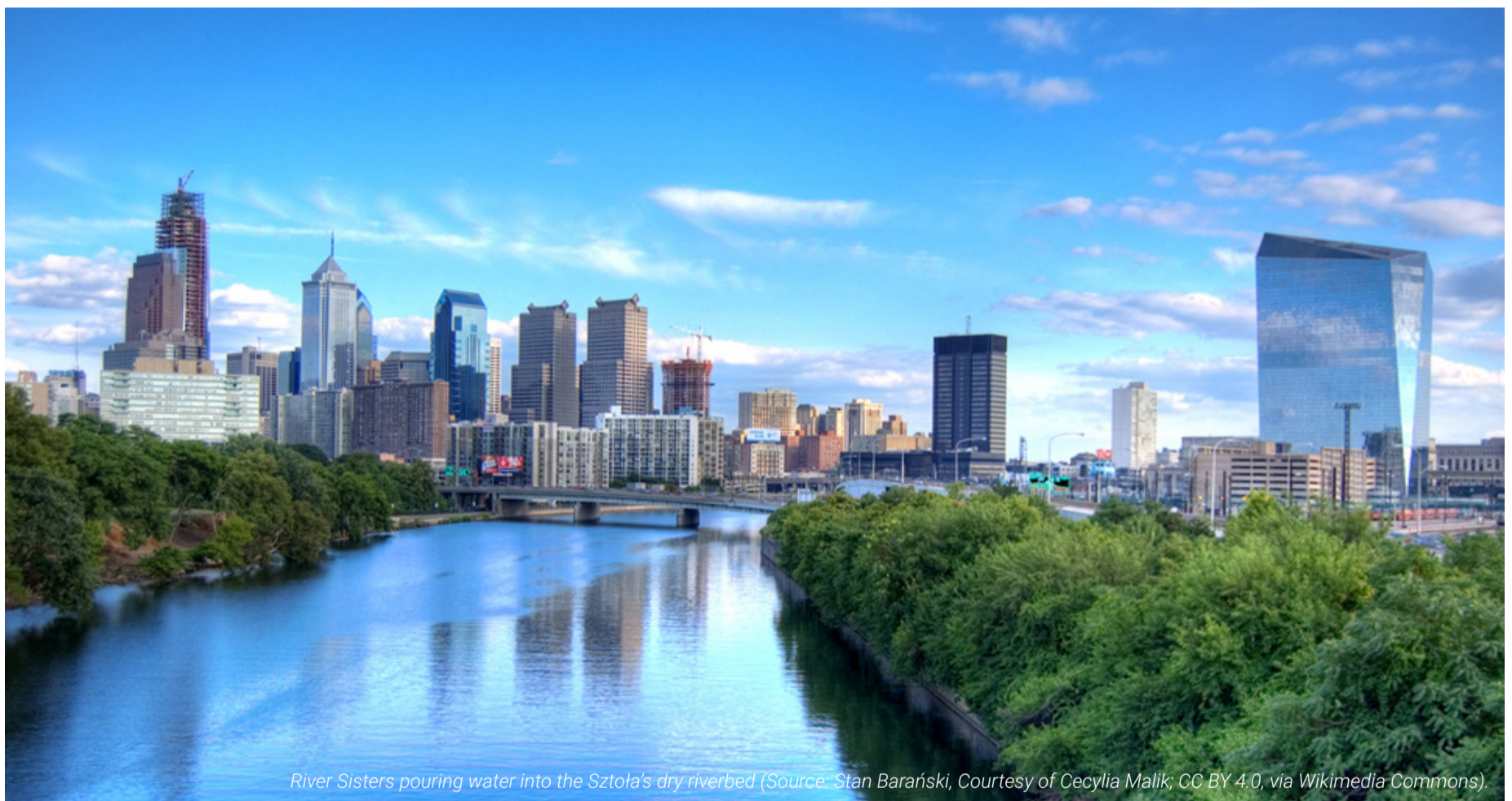


The United Nations of Rivers, Deltas and Estuaries

DAY 1: River Walk along the Schuylkill
